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Bookshelf Basics

- ☐ Mac, Windows, iOS, Android, & Online
- Every account includes:
 - 2 computers, 2 mobile devices, online access
- Synchronization across devices
- Notes and highlights
- ☐ Full book download
- □ 1 year online access, keep download as long as desired





Blackboard Building Block

- ☐ Will be pre-installed starting with SP 14
- Builds the content into the courses
 - Single sign on directly to the content
- Usage analytics at the course level
- ☐ User-level launch preferences
 - Bookshelf online or native apps
- ☐ Support resources in Tools section



Notes & Highlights

- ☐ Synchronized across the users devices
 - 3 options: Private, Friends, Anyone
 - Subscribers need account email address
 - Mobile devices don't currently display the author
 - Unlimited highlighters
 - Ability to export notes and highlights
 - Copy and paste also creates the reference to the title



Online/Offline Access

- End users are able to download the full title to the native applications
- ☐ Students can keep the download version after the course
- ☐ Students can access content directly, no need to use Blackboard as entry point
- ☐ Synchronization can only occur with internet connection
- ☐ Content updates available across all platforms



Content Types

- ☐ 2 types of content: PDF and Reflowable
- ☐ Reflowable has a better experience for smaller screens
- Experience will vary
- Encouraged publishers to provide Reflowable but some titles will be PDF
- □ Recommend requiring Reflowable content going forward from all publishers

Steps for Faculty

- ☐ Click on e-textbook in your course
- ☐ Accept EULA
- ☐ Provide existing account details or create new account
- □ Access content online
- ☐ Launch native app to download content



Steps for Students

- ☐ Click on e-textbook in your course
- ☐ Accept EULA
- ☐ Access content online through a reference account
 - Ref. Acct. allows for online access through Blackboard
- ☐ In order to access content through native apps the students need to finish configuring account

Best Practices

- ☐ Faculty that share notes and highlights
 - Highest student satisfaction and adoption
- ☐ Encourage the use of note sharing among study groups
- □ Spend some time at the beginning of the semester exploring the content
- □ Remind students of the available online resources
- ☐ Utilizing deep links for weekly assignments increases satisfaction



Reporting Available

- ☐ Individual usage statistics available to faculty
 - Access through Course Tools in Blackboard
- ☐ Aggregated report available through VitalSourceReporter
 - See aggregated data per title
- ☐ Individual usage for all courses available via feed
- ☐ Remind students of the available online resources
- ☐ Utilizing deep links for weekly assignments increases satisfaction
