Disabling the Google Chrome Pop-up Blocker

Introduction

- Google Chrome features a pop-up blocker that can prevent new windows from opening.
- We recommend turning off all pop-up blockers while using Pearson web sites.
- Please follow the instructions in the upcoming slides to be sure that most new windows that open on Pearson web sites are not blocked.

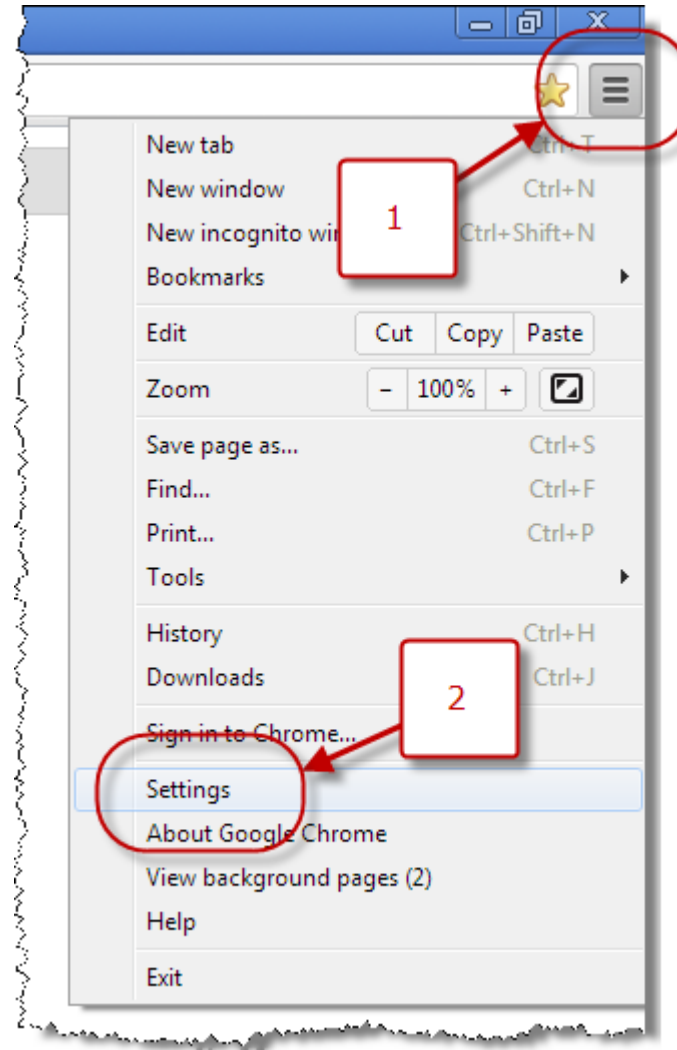
Note: To access content after disabling or configuring your pop-up blocker you may need to refresh the web page.

Accessing the Google Chrome Settings menu

Step 1: Open Chrome and click the Chrome menu (☰), or in older versions, the wrench icon (🔧).

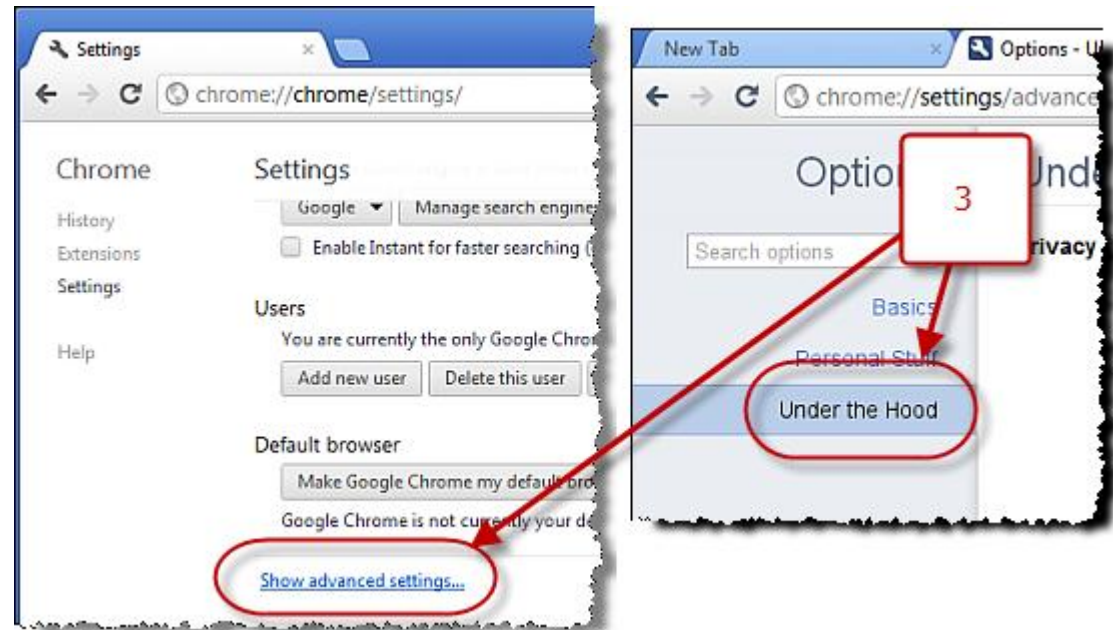
Step 2: In *Windows*: Click **Settings** (or in older versions, **Options**)

In *Mac OS X*: Click **Preferences**.



Accessing the Advanced Settings menu

Step 3: Scroll down to the Privacy heading (you may need to click **Show advanced settings**, or in older versions, **Under the Hood**)



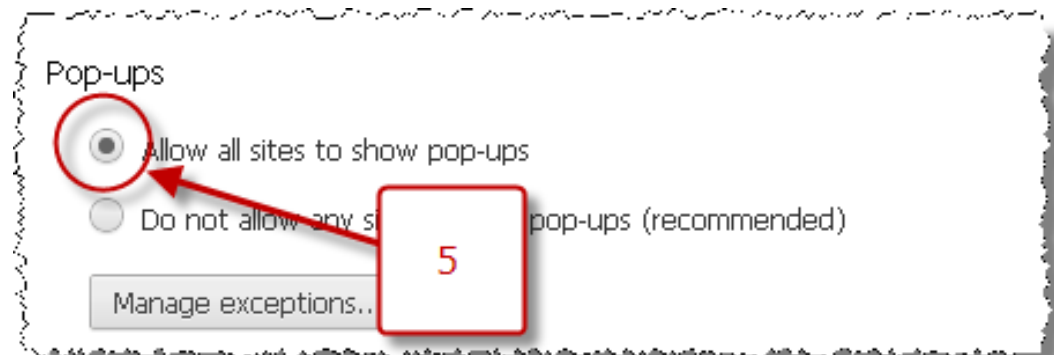
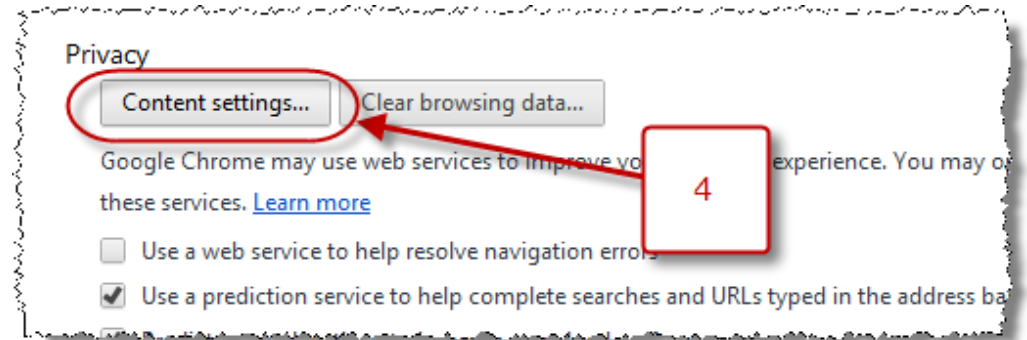
Accessing the Content Settings menu

Step 4: In the Privacy section, click **Content settings**.

Step 5: In the Pop-ups section, select "Allow all sites to show pop-ups"

Step 6: Click **Done**

Step 7: Click the "x" to the right of the Settings - Content Settings tab to close it
