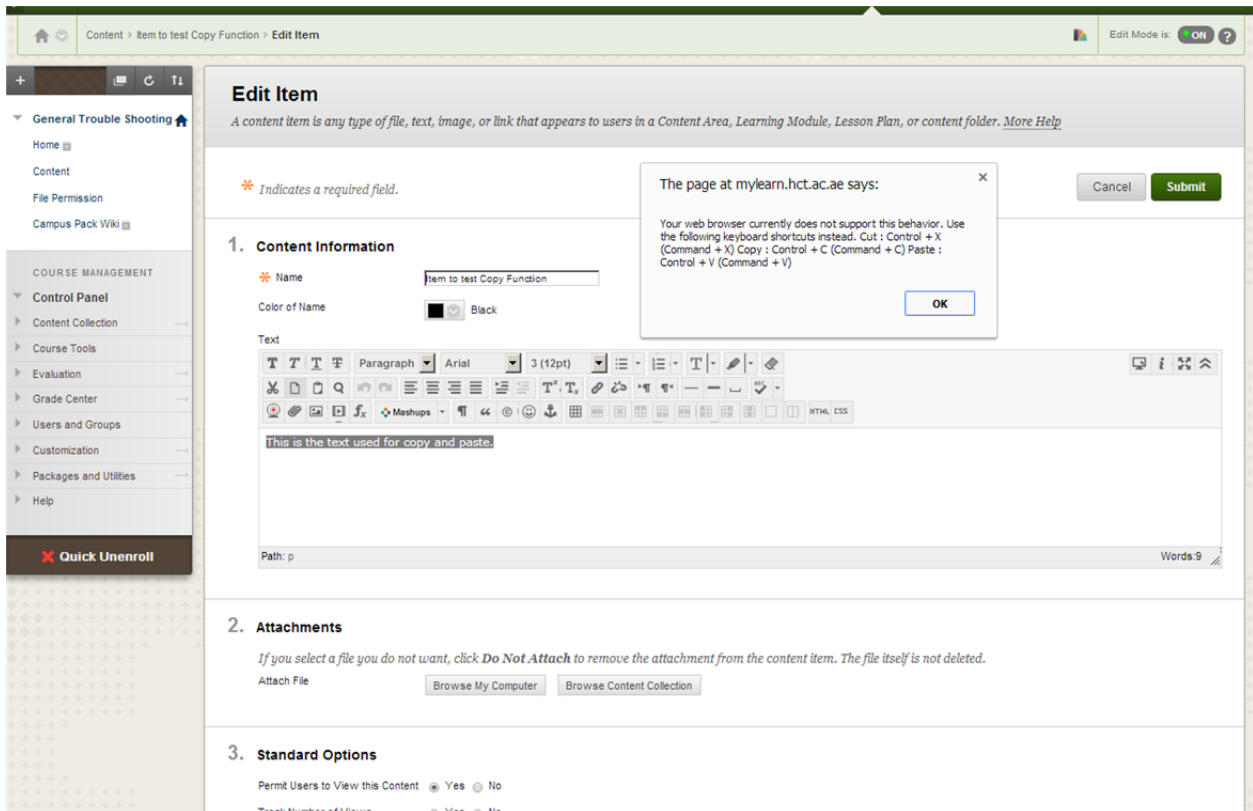
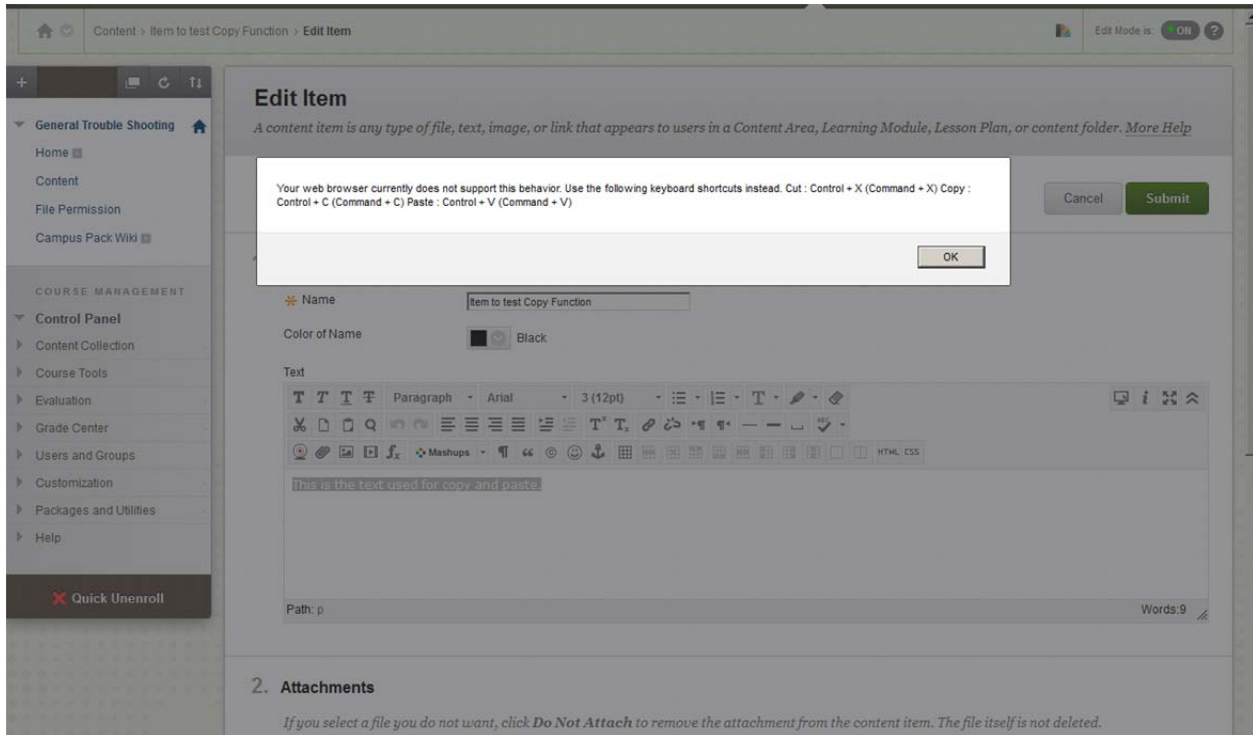


Issue: Copying the content from the text editor of an item through Firefox 22.0 and Google Chrome 29.0, it gives the error as attached in the screen shots. However, the shortcut keys working fine.



The underlying problem is due to Firefox not allowing JavaScript application access to the clipboard by default according to new security implementations introduced with latest Firefox versions. You can check the following articles for more details and how JavaScript can be enabled in Firefox.:

- 1.Copy text from VTBE (ctrl+c)
- 2.Paste in other text editor (such as word or notepad) (ctrl+p)
- 3.Copy again (ctrl+c)
- 4.Paste in the second VTBE window (ctrl+p)
